



## 2 Survey

Now ask other pupils what they think of the condition of the sanitary facilities. This step is important, because by this you can prove later that other pupils share your opinion. Their answers might even open up new ideas and insights.

You can proceed as follows:

- a) Use the questionnaire below.  
 Ask pupils to assign marks to toilets, washing rooms and showers.  
 Ask them for the grade they belong to.  
 Take notes of everything they say about toilets, washing rooms and showers.  
 If you have finished this you can easily calculate the average mark for each sanitary facility. Also evaluate the remarks.
- b) If there are more – or totally different – questions regarding sanitary facilities, develop your own questionnaire. Have your teacher help you.

In any case you should question *at least* 20 pupils from different grades. Ask them *in a friendly way* to take part in your survey. It makes sense to do the questioning in pairs of two, one can answer the questions and the other one writes down the answers.
